Michael Horberg, MD:

By creating a very safe space, we can help you deal with the issues that are unique to the community directly.

It starts with the front desk with our clinical assistant. It's our physicians, it's our case manager, our endocrinologist, our general surgeons, everyone involved in that care.

Stephanie Letourneau, MD:

I've been working with the LGBTQ community for over 15 years. I might offer STD testing. I might talk about PrEP with you, gender affirming hormone therapy.

E. W. Emanuel, MD:

I know if you're going to surgery what you may encounter because you're a trans person. The surgical team was quite comfortable and accustomed to my population. They understand the needs as well.

Michael Horberg, MD:

We're going to ask you about your health, including your gender and sexual health. We'll be glad to give you the care you need and you deserve.
